

The Alan Crothall SCHOLARSHIP

The Alan Crothall Scholarship may be awarded annually to one or more beneficiaries to meet expenses for tertiary education.

- Beneficiaries, the Alan Crothall Scholars, will undertake a course of study on a full-time basis unless the Trustees consider that part-time study is appropriate.
- The financial resources of scholarship applicants will be considered and preference given to those who, in the opinion of the Trustees, do not have adequate funds from any other source to enable them to complete their selected course of study.
- Scholarship applicants should have had some supervisory or management responsibilities and demonstrate to the Trustees a potential to benefit from further management education.
- Scholarship applicants should be, or have been employed, in NZIM Southern's membership area. They may be members of the NZIM Southern's staff.
- It is envisaged that Scholarships will be awarded annually. This may include awarding the Scholarship to the same individual over a number of years to enable a course to be completed. However, the Trustees reserve the right not to award a Scholarship in any one year.
- The Trustees may award more than one Scholarship in any one year.
- The Scholarship may be up to \$4,000.
- Scholarship applicants should preferably be aged between 23 and 35.

The Alan Crothall AWARD

The Alan Crothall Award may be made annually to one or more beneficiaries to meet the expenses of a short course of full or part-time study in New Zealand or Australia.

- Award applicants must be Course Leaders (or similar) of NZIM Southern Inc.
- The Trustees will expect applicants, if successful, to continue to serve NZIM for a reasonable period of time as course leaders or similar involvement.
- Award applicants must demonstrate to the Trustees the potential to benefit from further management education.
